

The InterFaith Basketball League has a Code of Conduct Policy that all participants, coaches and attendees of games must adhere to. This policy aligns with our purpose of providing a recreational, faith based, fun and athletic outlet for boys and girls from 3rd Grade through 12th Grade.

Anyone who causes a disturbance at an IFBL game is subject to removal from the gym by the gym supervisor, and then the AD/Commissioner will be notified. If the disturbance is threatening towards the gym supervisor, score keepers, other fans, coaches, players and/or officials, then that individual will not be allowed to attend any IFBL games/sponsored events for the remainder of the season. If an incident occurs during a tournament game, then that individual's suspension from games/events will carry over to the next season.

The IFBL would like to ask all participants to abide be the following points:

- All children whom are brought to watch the games need to be supervised at all times. Children playing on equipment in the gym, lobby or any other areas is prohibited.
- Unless authorized no one is allowed to use gym equipment, rooms, stages or be running/playing in the hallways during games/events.
- Everyone is expected to exhibit sportsmanship at all times.
- No one is allowed to approach, taunt or speak to anyone at the scores table during the game. All need to refrain from foul language, slurs and threats at all times.
- No one is allowed to approach the scores table during the game. Please be aware the score board is not the officials score during the game.
- No one should approach an official in a disrespectful manner or direct inappropriate/hostile comments towards them.
